- 1) It's never too soon to come to the CDC! First-year students can explore majors and career options, and our services continue to be available after graduation as well.
- 2) The Career Development Center provides a list of on- and off-campus part-time jobs.
- 3) Career Development reviews cover letters and resumes for students prior to their job search process.
- 4) Jobs and internships are posted through Ram Career Network, an online database available to all students.
- 5) Students can get help during regular drop-in hours Monday-Friday, 1-3 PM, or by appointment.
